# CAT ACT 2011

## Cat Requirements

### Ownership

Owner of the cat must not be under the age of 18

Cat must be microchipped.

Cats must be sterilized, unless approval has been obtained from the Shire of Narrogin for you to act as a registered breeder.

## Concessions

If owner holds a pension card they are eligible for a 50% discount on registration fees, Proof of identity and pension card must be shown.

## Nuisance

Wandering cats can prove to be a nuisance for neighbours, particularly non cat owners. If Council Ranger deems your cat to be a nuisance, you may be required to confine your cat within your premises.

## Cancellation of Registration

Cat Registration can be cancelled if;

- The owner is fined or convicted for 2 or more offences in any one year
- The cat has been shown to be destructive, dangerous, vicious, unduly mischievous, or to be suffering from an infectious disease

## Impoundment

In the unfortunate case that the cat is seized and impounded the owner has 5 working days to collect the cat, before it is disposed of.

Impoundments fees:

- Unregistered is \$100.00
- Registered is \$30.00

All fees need to be paid before the cat is released, plus an additional \$10.00 per day the cat is kept in the pound.

**If your cat is missing please contact the Shire of Narrogin (08)9880 0900 or the Regulatory Services Officer on 0448 873 207, as soon as possible to check if it has been impounded.**

**The Cat Act 2011 requires registration tags is to be worn at all times.**
