Internet and WiFi



Three public access computers provide free access to the Internet for research/study purposes and a small fee of \$2.00/half hour (\$1.50 conc), \$4.00/hour (\$3.00 conc) for email, social networking, games etc with up to two hours per day depending on demand. Word processing and photocopying, scanning, laminating and disc cleaning facilities are also available.

- Storytime sessions for children aged 2-5 years old on Wednesdays at 10.30 am.
