Narrogin Regional Child Care Services Inc. was established in 1988 as a multifunctional service. This service is now known as Regional Early Education and Development -Narrogin (REED). This multifunctional service caters to the needs of Narrogin and its surrounding community by providing different types of child care:

- The Child Care Centre is licensed to care for fifty-seven (57) children and provides for both permanent and occasional care. The service is a not for profit organisation. We are Government approved for Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate.
- Narrogin Outside School Hours Care (NOSH) provides licenced quality education and care for children Before School, After School and for Vacation care.
- Great Beginnings Family Day Care Service provides childcare in registered Educators homes in Narrogin and across regional and remote Western Australia. Each home is a registered service and is governed by service Policies and Procedures, the National Education and Care Regulations and the National Law 2012. The Service Coordination Unit assists Educators with licensing procedures and governance, fee processing, supporting the delivery of quality care and education and it offers a well-resourced toy library service.
- Mobile Occasional Child Care Service provides licensed child care to outlying towns. Our qualified staff travel to communities to provide the children in small towns with a quality child care program.
