
The Committee noted the Council Resolution.

7.3 ENTRY STATEMENT UPDATE - EMTRS

The EMTRS recently noticed new stone planter boxes in one of the main streets in Wagin. The EMTRS contacted the Shire of Wagin to enquire about the stone planter boxes and to get details for the TAC, should they be interested in this style of stone for potentially Entry Statement replacement. There was a total of 6 of these planter boxes supplied and installed for a total cost of \$41,000 so on average \$6,833.33 each. The photo is presented to the TAC for discussion.



The EMTRS advised that he is meeting with the stone mason later this week and he will report back to the next meeting with more information.
